AN EASY PLAN ...create a big plan in minutes with a simple form



S ometimes a little planning gives big benefits. Many people believe that for a plan to have value, it must be long and complicated. It does not need to be. Some of the most significant planning can be done in a few moments.

Many of us want to provide for our family and the causes we cherish but don't want the hassle of amending or updating our wills or estate plans. While an up-to-date will is important, you can accomplish many of your goals outside of your will.

Think about where you have most of your assets:

- Savings account
 Checking account
- Investment account Retirement account: IRA, 401(k), 403(b)

Most of your assets are probably held in one or more of these accounts. If you plan to leave funds from any of them to your family or to the causes you support, you can make your designation with a simple form.

Contact your account administrator and ask for a beneficiary designation form or payable on death form. No matter what your administrator calls it, it allows you to transfer assets automatically when you pass away.

You can change your mind and change this form quite simply. You can also designate percentages for example, 50% to your spouse and 50% to a charity you would like to support. While these can be given outside your will, it should still be a part of your larger plan, so be sure to check with your attorney or accountant to make sure these designations support your larger goals.

YEAR-END GIVING

Annual Giving Campaign – Kicked off mid-October and runs till December 31st. This is the once a year request from Posada Life Foundation to support those programs that add to the quality of life at La Posada. Many donors wait until the end of the year before making a charitable donation, which is fine. If you want your gift to be applied to the 2021 tax year, please remember the following La Posada policies:

- For a gift of securities, the law states that the date of the gift is the date that the assets reach the La Posada account, which may take days or even weeks. *Suggestion: Initiate the gift no later than Monday, December 6th. Earlier would be safer.*
- For gifts of cash, the date of the gift is the date that is postmarked on the envelope if mailed, or received in the Foundation office if hand delivering. Some donors, however, believe that the date of the gift is some other date, such as the date that they tell their broker to make the gift or the date on the check they write to make the gift. That is incorrect.

Suggestion: If making a gift in person at Posada Life Foundation office, please try to bring your check in no later than Tuesday, December 28th.
