

Since 2009 over \$1.5 million dollars has been awarded out.

Regular Scholarship

Regular scholarships are available to all La Posada employees. An employee may receive up to \$2,500 per academic year to pursue their education and training. There is a \$5,000 lifetime limit for regular scholarship awards per person.

To be eligible, an employee must have worked for La Posada for at least six months, be in good standing and demonstrate satisfactory academic progress for continued financial support.

2022 High School Scholarships Awarded \$8,100.00 Total of 10 Recipients

High School Scholarship

To help high school employees begin their higher education journey, the Scholarship Program provides scholarships to qualified high school graduating seniors.

To be eligible for a scholarship between \$500 and \$1,000, the student must have been employed for a minimum of six months before graduating. The amount of scholarship award is based on their tenure.

Applicants must be in good standing with La Posada.


Endowments

The Foundation established the Wendell Bowers Endowment with the transfer of \$30,000 from the current Regular Scholarship Fund in 2006.

Donors who gift \$25,000 or more for a Scholarship under the Bowers endowment may name the gift in memory or honor of a special person.

A maximum of 5% of earnings will be awarded each year, thus ensuring the original donation will be held in perpetuity.


This endowment is in honor of Paul Bash.



Ruth Benson Endowment

As a child, Ruth Benson was surrounded by books and music, and by parents who fostered curiosity and a love for learning. In the depths of the Great Depression, her father and mother made certain Ruth could attend college. Following her graduation, Ruth became a high school teacher. During the 20 years she lived at La Posada, Ruth supported the employee scholarship fund because she believed in the power of education, and deeply appreciated the many services provided by the talented young people she met at La Posada.

This scholarship was established in May 2020, when Ruth passed away at 104.



Wendell Bowers Endowment

Wendell was passionate about service to others and also valued the importance of education. Upon moving to La Posada, he immediately started working to establish a scholarship program for the employees to further their education. As the program grew and developed, it received local, state, and national recognition. In 2004, Wendell received the Volunteer of the Year award from AZAHA, a state association working on behalf of those serving seniors in Arizona. In 2006, he was honored with the National Community Champion Award from the National Association of Area Agencies on Aging.

This endowment has been established in his name.



Betty "Bee" Burtis Endowment

Bee Burtis resided at La Posada from 1999 until her passing in 2004. She always enjoyed the dining experience at La Posada and became interested in the young careers of many of the servers and cooks. As a result of her interest, Bee's son Andy, a master chef, established an annual scholarship in memory of his mother.

This scholarship is to be awarded to Dining Services staff.




Willard & Marian Nyquist Endowment

His successful career culminated with General Tire Company, where he was vice president of the chemical division.


The Schmeisers were blessed with two children, a son and daughter, who died in separate tragic events as young adults. Through organ donation, they helped countless others around the country. "They carried on and live through other people." Grace Said.

Upon retirement, Al and Grace followed their passion for golf and moved to Green Valley, Arizona. Grace was also an avid bridge player and belonged to Desert Hills Country Club and Green Valley Country Club where she enjoyed many social gatherings with friends. After Alfred's passing in 2005, Grace moved to La Posada in Green Valley.

In addition to supporting the Community Foundation, Grace wanted to show her appreciation to the staff at La Posada and created the Alfred and Grace Schmeiser Scholarship Endowment for La Posada employees. Grace was a significant donor to Notre Dame University and the Salvation Army. She also funded the Al and Grace Schmeiser Angiography Suite at Carondelet St. Joseph's Hospital.

Grace passed away peacefully at her home on December 9, 2020. Her generosity and commitment to helping those in need will continue in perpetuity.

Over the course of her long life, Grace determined that her legacy would be best served by providing unrestricted, endowed support.



Donald & Mary Shropshire Endowment

Don and Mary Ruth Shropshire hold a special place in the hearts of the La Posada team and in the history of La Posada and Green Valley.

Hank Van Veen Endowment

Hank was born in Amsterdam, Holland in 1929, the year of the stock market crash and the beginning of the worldwide "Great Depression." His father was a carpenter and his mother was a sales clerk in a clothing store. Both believed in the high value of education and decided they could afford to raise and educate only one child, and that was Hank.

"My language and trading education stood me in good stead and I had a very successful career with Cargill Incorporated, trading commodities internationally and managing the world's largest soybean processing business. I traveled the world in search of oilseed processing investment opportunities. By the time I retired at age 60, I was an executive vice president in charge of a business group that operated 40 processing plants in the United States and 8 foreign countries, employing 4,000 people. After my retirement, I spent the next 4 years getting a degree from the University of Minnesota majoring in International Business. That goes to show what education and hard work can do for you.

I started looking for opportunities to help others get their education and the La Posada Scholarship Fund was the ideal solution. It gives me great pleasure to be able to do this, but there are two things I would like to ask of you:

First, work hard to get all you can out of your scholarship money. It will pay off in the long run. Secondly, sometime in the future, look for an opportunity to pass it forward."
